Roy Dailey (Teddy Dailey's father) is at Roe Rehab & slowly improving. Prayers.

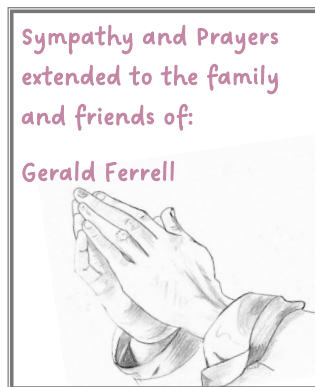
EXTENDED SICKNESS: (has been on the sick list for some time now)...

Have We Measured Ourselves Lately? By Mike Riley

The following questions are good indicators of spiritual growth:

Do we spend time reading God’s word and talking with Him each day in prayer? (2 Timothy 2:15 ASV; 1 Thessalonians 1:2).

Do we look forward to fellowshiping with the Lord? (Hebrews 10:23-25). What “fruit of the Spirit” is apparent in our life? (Gal. 5:22).

Do we talk about Jesus with people who don’t know Him? (Luke 14:23). How are we using our God-given talents? (Matthew 25:14-30).

Do we have a generous and giving spirit? 2 Corinthians 8:1-5). How much better do we know God today than we did a year ago?(1 John 2:3-5).
