Let Us Reason Together

"Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." — Isaiah 1:18

God's invitation to Israel through Isaiah still calls to us today. It is a plea for honest reflection, not blind rebellion. The Lord does not thunder condemnation without first offering conversation. He says, "Come now!" Not tomorrow, not when it is convenient, but come now. Sin stains the soul, yet God desires to cleanse.

The Hebrew word translated "reason" carries the idea of arguing a case or settling a matter. God invites His people to consider the evidence. He shows them the seriousness of their sin, but also the greatness of His mercy. The scarlet stain of sin was permanent under the Law, but grace can do what the law could never do and make a sinner clean.

The Lord does not call us to reason with human pride, but with humble hearts. Many try to excuse sin, redefine it, or hide it. But sin cannot be reasoned away. It must be confessed. When we come to God with an penitent heart, He promises to forgive and to cleanse. John wrote, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).

Notice also the contrast. Scarlet and crimson (deep, lasting stains) are replaced with snow and wool, symbols of purity and newness. This is not a surface wash. It is a deep clean! The blood of Jesus Christ washes away all kinds of sins.


God still reasons with men through His Word. He calls sinners to repentance and saints to faithfulness. The invitation remains open. He does not say, "Depart," but "Come."

Will you come? Will you reason with the Lord about your life, your soul, and your eternity? His logic is simple and His love is strong: "Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as
